

DROPPING OBJECTS

EARLY INTERVENTION WITH YOUR YOUNG CHILD

Every child is different. Do what works best for encouraging your child's independent exploration of this suggested activity.



ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION:

Help your child notice that things fall down by talking about what happens when something falls off a table or when they drop an object.

STEM LEARNING AREA:

Physical Science (concepts related to objects/things, what they do, and how they move):

- Force & Motion (concepts related to objects moving, how they move, and how to make them move)
- Gravity (force that pulls things to each other; especially things to the ground)

STEM PROGRESSION STEP:

Gravity Noticer: Has an intuitive understanding that things will fall down

WHAT CAN I SAY?:

- Fall, Fell, Down, Dropped
- "Uh oh! The car fell down again! Let's see. Do you think this one will also fall down?"
